



EDINBURGH STUDENT LAW REVIEW COPYRIGHT OF SUBMISSIONS

The Edinburgh Student Law Review (ESLR) is an open access journal built on the principles of sharing academic works for the benefit of the wider community. As such, authors retain the copyright to their submission and submissions can be published by the ESLR in two ways:

- the author releases the work under a Creative Commons licence, which allows users to reuse, copy, publish, perform or communicate the work, provided certain conditions are met (see <http://creativecommons.org/>); or
- the author grants to the ESLR the non-exclusive right to publish the work online and reserve all his/her rights.

The default option for publication, unless the author states otherwise, is to release the work under an Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivatives Creative Commons Licence.
